Possible Surface Repair Technician Certification in North Texas

To comply with requirements contained in ACI 562 – Code Requirements for Assessment, Repair and Rehabilitation, ICRI has launched their new Concrete Surface Repair Technician (CSRT) Certification Program. The certification program has two tiers:

- Tier 1 only applicants are those who may not be regularly engaged in concrete surface repair inspection and testing, yet have an active interest in learning more about the inspection and tests. You will be introduced to types of concrete deterioration, understand the requirements for a quality concrete surface repair, be aware of repair materials and methods, and be qualified to perform pre and post-placement inspections and testing.
- Tier 2 applicants are those who seek full certification. Both tiers require participation in five (5) online training modules, with each module incorporating education, training, and questions.

Tier 1 must be completed online prior to beginning Tier 2.

Tier 2 can be performed in person, or video recorded remotely if the applicant has access to the required equipment. The equipment can be rented from ICRI National for a fee. However, the North Texas Chapter is gauging interest in holding a group Tier 2 certification in North Texas in early 2018. If enough applicants attend, all needed equipment would be provided, and instructors from ICRI National would travel to North Texas to complete the certification.

Cost for Tier 1 is \$360 for members, \$400 for non-members. Cost for both Tier 1 and Tier 2 is \$480 for members and \$560 for non-members.

JUNE MEETING RECAP

During a delicious Tex-Mex lunch at Mattito's in Dallas on June 8, 2017, members and affiliates of the North Texas Chapter listened to a presentation on the impending changes to the OSHA regulations regarding silica dust, which are expected to be implemented in

September of 2017. A crowd of 41 attended the meeting to hear the presentation by Jasher Sutton (Regional Manager for Hilti) and Ignacio Nemirovsky (Concrete Trade Manager of Hilti), as well as a few of their colleagues, discuss the important provisions of the new OSHA regulations, many of which are sure to be of critical importance to the concrete repair industry. Among the topics of discussion were the "White Papers", which were developed by Hilti and a consortium of about 25 other companies and organizations, to

help those in the construction industry understand the biggest compliance issues with the new standards. New permissible exposure limits, which are being implemented to prevent silica-related deaths and illnesses, were reviewed along with several available options for employers to ensure their employees are protected. While many questions exist regarding the enforcements of the provisions, all in attendance were grateful for the opportunity to discuss methods of compliance and some of the intricacies of the new standards with Mr. Sutton, Mr. Nemirovsky, and the rest of the North Texas group.

NTX 2017 SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

The North Texas Chapter provides annual scholarships to our members, their families, and others in the community. Each year multiple scholarships of at least \$1,000 have be awarded to high school seniors and college undergraduate students, who are pursuing a certificate or degree from a college, university, or trade school.

This year the Chapter received 20 applications from a wide variety of high school and college students. These were carefully reviewed and a set of seven finalists was selected. From these, three students were selected to receive scholarships.

First Place went to Caleb Myers. Caleb graduated from DISD's Townview School of Science and Engineering with a GPA of 3.7 and was inducted into the National Honor Society as a sophomore. He is now a freshman at Prairie View A&M University, where he plans to major in chemical engineering. Caleb will receive a \$1,500 scholar-ship from the Chapter.

Second place was a tie between Alexander Nervo and Gabriela Proce. Both are currently enrolled at the University of Texas at Arlington (UTA) where they are studying civil engineering. Both will receive a \$1,000 scholarship from the Chapter.

Gabriela is from Rowlett and is now a senior with a focus in Transportation. This past summer she was an intern for Huitt-Zollars and has been active in the student chapters of the American Society of Civil Engineers, American Public Works Association, and Society of Women Engineers.

In addition to studying civil engineering, Alex is also studying applied mathematics and is in his sophomore year. He plans to pursue a master's degree once he completes his undergraduate studies. In addition to school, Alex, who is an Arlington resident, is active in the community where he has been an Election Clerk (2014 to 2016) and an Election Judge in Tarrant County this past year.
