


## **ICRI Executive Committee Summer Meeting**

At the recently completed ICRI Executive Committee summer meeting held in Minneapolis, the following information was provided on upcoming events and conventions:

- 2019 ICRI Kick-Off Party will be held on Monday January 21, 2019 at the Chateau
  at the Paris Hotel in Las Vegas, prior to the start of World of Concrete. Hotel reservations are available: <a href="https://www.worldofconcrete.com/en/hotel-travel/">https://www.worldofconcrete.com/en/hotel-travel/</a>

- Arrangements are being finalized for the 2019 ICRI Spring Convention scheduled for April 8-10 in Jacksonville, FL. If you check those dates on the calendar, you will notice that that convention will be held Monday-Wednesday, instead of the traditional Wednesday-Friday. The Meeting/Event Planning staff and the Conventions Committee have found that there are more hotel options available during this portion of the week, and at better prices. The schedule for the convention is still being worked out, but there is a chance that the first technical Sessions will be held on Monday afternoon instead of on Monday morning.
- The 2019 ICRI Fall Convention is being planned for Philadelphia November 11-13, 2019, which also is Monday-Wednesday.
- 2020 Convention locations under consideration include Vancouver, BC and Denver, CO for the Spring, and Minneapolis and Miami for the Fall
