



# NTX HOLDS JOINT MEETING AT UT-ARLINGTON

The North Texas Chapter held its annual joint meeting with the ASCE Student Chapter at the University of Texas at Arlington on Wednesday, April 3rd. Over eighty students and Chapter members were schooled on "Non-Destructive Testing/Evaluation of Concrete and Masonry Structures" by Todd Allen, President of Radarview, LLC. Mr. Allen described multiple technologies and methodologies that can used to find distressed areas in concrete and masonry structures beyond simple visual observations, including electrical, electromagnetic, and sonic/ultrasonic methods, in addition to in-situ strength testing. Mr. Allen noted that, while technology can be a valuable tool for engineers, using well-thought out methods of applying the technologies is the key to providing pertinent information that is of value to the engineer. Obtaining this information can be crucial to the process of making informed decisions regarding the evaluation of options for repair. Mr. Allen provided several examples of technologies used on past projects, explained why certain methods were used, and showed the results gained from the testing.

Just prior to Mr. Allen's presentation, Chapter President, Stephen Grelle, PE, and Chapter Scholarship Committee Chair, Julie Bolding, PE, presented Dr. Jim Williams with a \$2,000 check for the Civil Engineering Department's Scholarship Fund. Several years ago, the North Texas Chapter committed to providing the UTA Civil Engineering Department with a \$1,000 minimum donation to its scholarship fund. Due to the success of the Chapter's annual fundraising events, the Chapter has always been able to at least double this committed amount!


#### **EVENT INFORMATION**

- 1. There will be 10 shooting stations, 10 targets per station.
- 2. Stations circle the Pavilion, and are about 20-25 yards apart. Rotation between stations will be in numerical order.
- 3. Dallas Gun Club will have shells for sale at the Pavilion for \$10/box. No shells will be sold at the stations.
- 4. Golf carts are available with advance registration (see attached form).
- 5. Station sponsors may provide two people to staff their station, one person to push the button to throw the clays, and the other to mark the score sheet. Sponsors may set up their own canopy, table and chairs, and provide give-away items to the participants (please, no give-aways containing alcohol). All set-up must be completed by 9:00 AM.
- 6. Participants are encouraged to bring their own personal protective equipment safety glasses, hearing protection, etc. NTX ICRI will have limited quantity of safety glasses and ear plugs, if you need them.
