### PRESENTATION INFO:

Speaker Bio: Nate Poen is a Manager, Strengthening Solution for STRUCTURAL TECHNOLOGIES, LLC. He aides the contracting and structural engineering communities on different methods to repair and strengthen existing concrete structures. Nate is a civil engineering graduate of Iowa State University.

Abstract: Use of post tensioning systems in concrete structures started in the mid 1950's. By placing the concrete in compression, it increased its strength and many other benefits such as longer spans, less columns, thinner/lighter sections, reduced shoring/reshoring time, etc. which all offer both engineering and cost advantages.

Typical post tensioning prestressing steel, anchors, sheathing and protection systems have all dramatically changed since their inception. This presentation will discuss the evolution of these changes, the problems they created, repair strategies and the long-term solutions provided by the new encapsulated post tension systems that are used today.

Also presented will be modifications to post tension slabs such as penetrations, typical damage and repair, means, methods and materials used to address these problems.


