Material and Labor Volatility and What it Means for North Texas Construction:

#### A Round Table Discussion

Over the past several months the construction sector, including the concrete repair industry, has been affected by escalating material costs, shortages and lengthening delivery times, as well as by issues with securing labor. Across commercial construction, the price increases have caused contractors to rework the material costs on their jobs, and the uncertainty is resulting in owners reconsidering the schedule of their projects. In North Texas, contractors have reported difficulties in securing concrete for their projects in recent months.

This round table, comprised of contractors, manufacturers, and engineers, is intended to be an interactive session to bring the participants together to discuss their recent experiences and their attempts to overcome the issues based on their first-hand knowledge of the industry and what they consider the trends may be over the summer and into end of the year.

Recently the National ICRI held a round table event for all chapters to participate on where



#### NTX GETS A LESSON ON JOINT SEALANTS, FILLERS, AND SEALANTS

On April 15, 2021, the North Texas Chapter hosted a virtual membership meeting with 25 members and chapter friends in attendance. During the meeting, Vance Pool of Euclid Chemical gave a very informative and topical presentation on slab joint sealants, joint fillers, densifiers, and sealers. Mr. Pool started off by discussing recent concrete industry trends, noting that despite the uncertainties created by the Covid-19 pandemic, that concrete structures were still a great value, especially considering recent upticks in the price of other construction materials. Several types of joints were discussed; the difference between construction joints and contraction/ control joints were made clear. Mr. Pool noted the usefulness of semi-rigid joint fillers for transferring hard wheel loads in warehouses, and provided guidelines for the design and installation of the fillers. Flexible sealants were also discussed, including various available types of materials and installation tips. Finally, Mr. Pool discussed the difference between liquid floor densifiers and penetrating sealers, along with the benefits that each can provide given a proper application. All who attended came away from the presentation with a strong grasp of ways to improve the durability and functionality of concrete floor slabs. The NTX Chapter thanks Mr. Pool for his time and the excellent presentation!

#### **NTX Holds 7th Annual Sporting Clay Classic**

On the spectacular morning of Friday, May 14, 2021, the North Texas Chapter hosted their 7th Annual Sporting Clay Classic at Dallas Gun Club in Lewisville, Texas. The tournament featured some tight competition, which was due in part to the participation of 79 shooters from 21 teams, the most ever in the history of the event.
