

- Mark LeMay—President's Award. Mark is well known around these parts as a former NTX Chapter President and a mainstay of the chapter. For anyone who has not attended ICRI Conventions, it's hard to describe just how ubiquitous Mark is and has been on the National level, as well. In addition to serving as a committee member and chair of numerous technical and administrative committees over the years, Mark also served as ICRI President in 2020. Pete also served terms on the ICRI Board of Directions as the Region 7 representative.
- Gerard Moulzolf—President. Despite residing in St. Paul, MN, Gerard has been a member of the
 NTX Chapter and has regularly participated in our chapter events for many years. Gerard began his
 term as ICRI President this year and was honored with a great video prepared by ICRI's Immediate
 Past President, Brian MacNeil, with well-wishes and kind words from Gerard's friends, family, and
 colleagues.

Those who were fortunate enough to attend the Luncheon got to hear the inspirational and heartfelt speeches from all of the honorees, including Mark, Pete. and Gerard.
